PENARTH CYTUN LENTEN LUNCHES

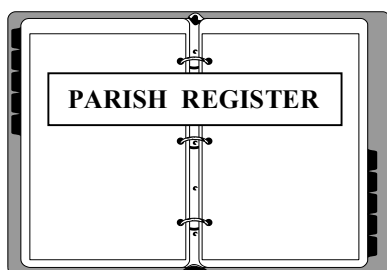
