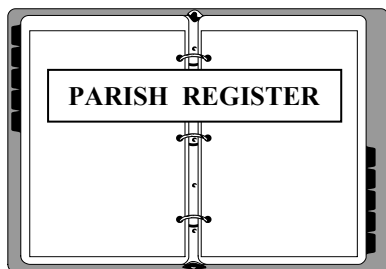

A MESSAGE FROM CAFOD.

The emergency in Mozambique, Zimbabwe and Malawi, caused by Cyclone Idai, is unfolding before our eyes, and millions of people have been made homeless as well as the communities as yet unaccounted for. We have to do something and we know that the Catholic community will want to respond. Our local representatives are already at work in the Southern Africa region but they need our support. We do not make this request lightly. We are conscious of your amazing generosity for our recent Fast Day Collection but the situation is so urgent it cannot wait.

SYRIAN REFUGEE FAMILIES PROJECT – CHANGE OF PLAN.

As previously reported, the Diocese is now preparing to house its **fourth refugee family**, this time an **Iraqi Christian family**. This work is close to the heart of **Pope Francis** who encourages all dioceses and religious communities to **'welcome the stranger' into their midst**. It also **brings to life the Bidding Prayers** we say each week "For the homeless and refugees". The **Lenten Diocesan Collection** this year should have been allocated to this project. However, due to the unfolding humanitarian disaster in Africa, the Syrian project will have to be put on hold for the moment. A **second collection** will now be taken in **St. Joseph's and St. Mary's** on the **5th Sunday of Lent** for the **Idai Cyclone disaster**.
