*May he rest in Peace.*

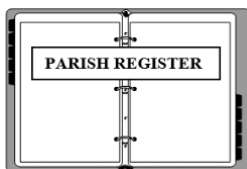
### ADRIAN STRAIN R.I.P.

### SYNOD NATIONAL SYNTHESIS – bishops' overview

“The Bishops of England and Wales have now completed their discernment of the National Synthesis Report and the two documents will be sent to the Synod Office in Rome as our submission from England and Wales, contributing to the work towards the Synod of Bishops' in 2023. The submissions from the various Bishops' Conferences should arrive in Rome by 15<sup>th</sup> August. These will be considered by the Synod Office and their collaborators and then the first *Instrumentum Laboris* will be produced. This document, which is the working document for the Continental Phase, will form the basis of the continued reflection on the Synodal Process. The Regional Meeting for Europe will be in Prague from 5-12 February 2023. We only have dates and no further information yet about the gathering. As we go into the summer, and people have a break from their usual routines, please keep the work of the Synodal Process in your prayers. No matter what emerges from the Synod of Bishops' in Rome in 2023, the work which has begun in our diocese and organisations must continue so that we focus on the mission of the Church in which all the baptized participate in proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ in today's world”.
