THE TRIDUUM

This begins on **Maundy Thursday** evening with the **Mass of the Lord's Supper** at 7.30pm in **St. Joseph's**. This is followed by **Eucharistic Adoration** at the Altar of Repose (Lady Chapel) **until 10.30pm**. At **10.15pm** the **Sorrowful Mysteries** of the Holy Rosary will be recited, taking us from the Garden of Gethsemane to Calvary.

GOOD FRIDAY at 3pm – We resume our journey in the footsteps of **Our Blessed Lord** with the **Solemn Good Friday Liturgy** in **St. Joseph's**.

HOLY SATURDAY at 8.30pm – We celebrate with joy together the **Easter Vigil Mass** in **St. Joseph's**. (During the Vigil Mass Nicola Newman will be baptised).

LENTEN PENITENTIAL SERVICE – THIS WEEK

The last of the Deanery Penitential Services takes place on Monday 26th March in St. Teilo's, Whitchurch at 7pm. Four or five priests will be in attendance.

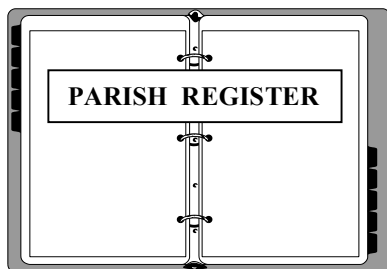
HOLY PLACES COLLECTION – GOOD FRIDAY

Otherwise the chaplaincy team will not know that the person is there. Due to the Data Protection Act, the team no longer has access to the list of Admissions. If no one from the Church has been to see the person in hospital, it is because they do not know the person is there.
