PRIEST TRAINING FUND - THIS WEEK.

The 4th Sunday of Easter is "Good Shepherd" Sunday and is traditionally World Day of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood and Religious Life. We have three student priests at the moment, who are at various stages of their 7years of preparation. They are **Elliot Hanson; Dale Cutlan, and Gwyn Jones.** The PTF Collection is there to support these students in their studies. The Archdiocese invests £189,000 in the formation of each seminarian over the duration of their seven years. And yet following ordination, a priest may give back more than 40 or 50 years' service. So the investment brings a considerable return. Please support the Priests' Training Fund as generously as you can.

Because of the impact of Social Distancing on the size of the congregation in our churches, we are unable to hold an annual PTF collection in the traditional way. We have therefore to find alternative ways of giving that are available to most people through their electronic devices or to others who choose not to use those methods.

There is a leaflet and a gift aid envelope which will be given out as you leave the church today. (Some of you will already have received one last weekend).

The leaflet explains the different ways of giving and how to gift aid your donation. If you have brought back your envelope containing your offering, you can drop it into the special bucket as you leave the church.

Finally you can push an ordinary envelope marked PTF through the presbytery door - whichever is most convenient. *Donations to the PTF will be matched £ for £ by the Jesuit Seminary and Mission Fund.

SACRAMENT OF RECONCILIATION.

Confessions have been reinstated to their Saturday morning slot in St. Joseph's but at the earlier time of **10am – 11am**. This will be for an initial period until the end of May. It will then be reviewed. The priest will use the sacristy as the confessional. Covid restrictions must be observed. A steward will be on-hand to assist.

INFO FOR FIRST HOLY COMMUNIONS 2021.

We are going ahead with First Holy Communion for the children who missed out in 2020 due to cancellation. Parents have been contacted by the catechists. A special Mass will take place in St. Joseph's on **Saturday 5th June at 11am**. Because of Covid restrictions attendance will be restricted to immediate family only. Sadly this cannot include the Prayer Partners. Mgr Joe and the catechists acknowledge with thanks the prayerful support they have given to the children and their families. The Mass will be streamed live for those unable to be there.

INFO FOR CONFIRMATION 2021.

All parents and candidates for Confirmation (Confirmandi) in Year 9 have now been contacted and they will meet twice before the ceremony on **June 18**th. The meetings will be on Monday 10th May and Monday 14th June at 7.30pm in St. Joseph's church and will follow Covid guidelines. Sadly we will not be able to invite parishioners to join the ceremony on 18th June but it will be live-streamed so that all can watch. We do ask you to pray for our young people. Current Year 8 will have a preparation programme and celebration in the next school year.

INFO RE INFANT BAPTISMS.

From **Sunday 2nd May** baptisms of infants can be arranged. There are quite a number that were postponed last year because of Lockdown. The Services still have to comply with covid restrictions and so will differ in certain respects from the normal baptismal liturgy. The new time will be 3pm on Sundays in St. Joseph's and **the maximum number of people present will be 15**. Initially parents are asked to phone the presbytery and make an appointment to meet with the parish priest, either on zoom or face-to-face in the church, to arrange a mutually convenient day and time.
