The Holy Year of Mercy

This Holy Year is a spiritual pilgrimage established by Pope Francis. It will run from 8th December 2015 to the 20th of November 2016. As Cardinal Vincent Nichols says in his introduction to the published Booklet "Companion to the Year", it's the Pope's" fervent desire is that this Jubilee Year is a fresh opportunity for everyone to experience the great mercy of God." Pope Francis will inaugurate the Year with the opening of a Holy Door of Mercy on December 8th in Rome. In our own Archdiocese, Holy Doors of Mercy will also be opened at Belmont Abbey, Bridgend, Merthyr (St. Mary's) and Newport (St Mary's). These are meant to be places of pilgrimages with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and where the Sacrament of Penance will be available.
