CLERGY RETIREMENT FUND

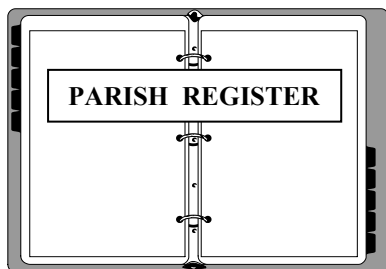
