If you have brought in your CAFOD boxes with the money collected please place them in the basket at the back of church. *Thanks for bringing them in.*

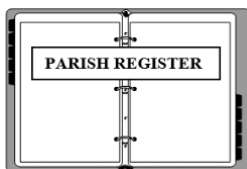
### STATIONS OF THE CROSS IN SCHOOL.
