

Toiletries for Asylum Seekers – Next Weekend!

The second of this year's collection of toiletries will take place **next weekend 2nd/3rd May.** Our collection now goes to Sister Ruth O'Neill of the Sisters of Charity of St. Vincent De Paul who is based in St. Francis Ely. She works with an organisation called Space-4-U, a drop-in centre for destitute asylum seekers located in Trinity Church on Newport Rd. You are asked to donate mostly toiletries for men, who are destitute and in most need. Please bring an item such as shaving foam, disposable razors, soap, toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, deodorant, comb and shower gel. There is also a need for some baby nappies and ladies' toiletries. A large box will be placed at the back of both churches for your donations. Please note the collection, as usual, will take place on **that weekend only.**
