### WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY – NEXT SUN

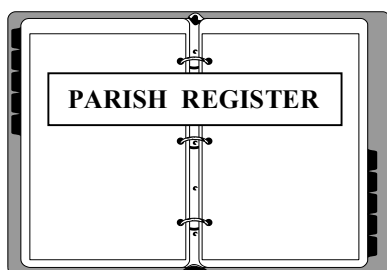
