SS PETER & PAUL HOLYDAY OF OBLIGATION

Wednesday 29th June is the solemnity of SS Peter and Paul and is a Holyday. In other words it should be treated as a Sunday. There are two Parish Masses in St Joseph's, 10am and 7.30pm. For those unable to attend, the Masses are both streamed live.

THE ACT OF SPIRITUAL COMMUNION

During the pandemic it has been the norm for the Priest to recite the prayer of St Alphonsus as an Act of Spiritual Communion for those watching on stream. The Bishops have now asked people to come back to Sunday Mass and to receive the Lord sacramentally in church and in the midst of the Eucharistic Community. The Act of Spiritual Communion will be discontinued at Mass from this weekend. JOINING IN AT ST JOSEPH'S


