Archbishop George has launched in the Cardiff Archdiocese the high –profile initiative "The Light is ON for You", to invite practising and lapsed Catholics to go to Confession this Advent. In common with other dioceses across England and Wales, we are reaching out to those who may have wandered from the life of the Church and those Mass-going Catholics who have been away from Confession for some years. Each Wednesday of Advent participating Catholic Parish Churches in the Archdiocese of Cardiff will be open from 7pm to 8pm on 3rd, 10th and 17th December for Catholics to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation. This means that 'The Light is ON for You' at these times in St. Joseph's, Penarth.
