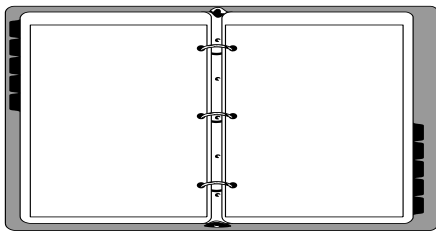

November Dead Lists

During November, Masses are said for specific intentions (where applicable) and also for the Holy Souls – in particular for those named in the November Dead Lists which are placed on the altar. **Special envelopes are available at the back of both churches.**

November – The Month of Remembrance

On the following **Tuesdays: Oct 28th, Nov 4th, Nov 11th and Nov 25th**, there will be a series of half-hour talks at the Cornerstone in Charles \Street, (opposite St. David's Cathedral), at 12.30pm, on subjects related to Life and Death. Refreshments will be served after the talks.

- **28th October: *Life After Death.*** Mr Des Robertson asks what the Catholic Church teaches us about death.
- **4th November: *Preparing Well for Eternal Life.*** Dom Paul Stonham OSB, Abbot of Belmont reflects on his experience in Latin America on this subject.
- **11th November: *Purification, Punishment, or Popish Propaganda?*** Rev Gareth Leyshon takes a fresh look at Purgatory.
- **25th November: *Life after Death (repeat)***

On **Friday 31st October**, at the Cornerstone, from 6.30-8.30pm, families of all ages are invited to an evening of games and activities to celebrate the true meaning of Hallowe'en: a Christian celebration of the saints, illuminated by Jesus '*the light of the world*'. The Night of Light is planned to be an alternative family celebration to Hallowe'en. There will be lots of fun – games, puzzles and craft activities. A light supper will be served.

Every Wednesday during the month of November, the Cornerstone will be "open to the public" from 11am to 2.30pm as a place of reflection for anyone who feels conscious of bereavement. Drop in at any time during these hours to find a warm welcome. Trained bereavement support volunteers will be available to listen and to talk with anyone who wishes to do so; there will also be reflective spots set up for people who just want to sit and reflect and pray. Refreshments will be available.

- There will be a special prayer service (not a Mass) for anyone whose life has been touched by the loss of a child in the womb, through birth or miscarriage, on **Friday 14th November** at Christ the King Church in Llanishen. The service will be offered twice, first at 1.30pm and again at 7.30pm.
