## FEAST OF SS PETER AND PAUL. JUNE 29<sup>TH</sup>.

Tuesday of this week is the Solemnity of SS Peter & Paul. Although it is not a Holyday of Obligation during the pandemic, nevertheless it is still a Holyday and so there will be a Vigil Mass on Monday night at 7.30pm and a morning Mass at 9.30am on Tuesday, the day of the feast.
