FEAST OF SS PETER AND PAUL. JUNE 29TH.

Tuesday of this week is the Solemnity of SS Peter & Paul. Although it is not a Holyday of Obligation during the pandemic, nevertheless it is still a Holyday and so there will be a Vigil Mass on Monday night at 7.30pm and a morning Mass at 9.30am on Tuesday, the day of the feast. Both these Masses will be in St. Joseph's and will be open to a restricted congregation. Both Masses will also be streamed live so that those who cannot be present can participate from where they are. **Please note that because of the Vigil Mass on Monday evening, there will be no morning Mass on Monday.**

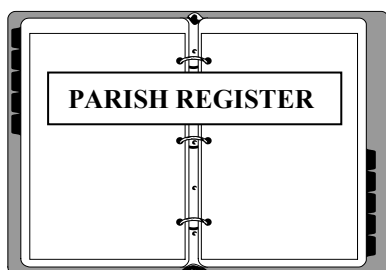
