### A CAUTIOUS COMING OUT OF LOCKDOWN.

In these unprecedented and extraordinary times, we have had to navigate the changing landscape of government restrictions and be on our guard against the variants of the virus. The rolling out of the vaccines will eventually ease the situation greatly, but at the moment it has reached only half of the adult population of the UK. There is still some way to go. Mgr. Joe has therefore opted to pursue a phased coming out of Lockdown and to be guided by the government's "road map".

**Having said that, arrangements are in hand to recommence Mass with a congregation in St. Joseph's from the weekend after Easter ie. April 10th /11<sup>th</sup>.**

From that weekend the Saturday and Sunday Masses only (ie. 5pm Sat and 9.30am Sun) will be open to parishioners. We will in effect be going back to the same format of Mass that we became so familiar with before the last Lockdown after Christmas. These Masses will still be subject to social distancing and therefore restricted to 50 persons per Mass. Weekday Masses – Mon, Wed, and Fri - will continue to be streamed live. Hopefully, as further restrictions are eased in May and June, parish life can resume, with a greater degree of normality.

### HOLY WEEK, THE TRIDUUM, AND STREAMING.

All Masses and Services during Holy Week and Easter, will be streamed live from St. Joseph's. To access the website see the Parish Register on page two of the gazette. Then click on "live Mass" from the main menu.

### HOLY WEEK AND EASTER SERVICES

Holy Week Services and the Sacred Triduum will be different this year because they have been adapted and shortened to accommodate the demands of the prevailing Covid restrictions. However, each of the Holy Week Services, including the Mass of Easter Day will conform to the specific guidance we have received from the Bishops' Conference of England and Wales as follows:

**Palm Sunday:** The blessing of palms takes place in the sanctuary without a procession. Blessed palms will be given only to those involved in the liturgy. The shorter form of the St. Mark's Passion will be read.

**Mass of the Lord's Supper:** The washing of the feet is omitted. The main altar becomes the "altar of repose" and a short period of adoration will follow at the end of Mass.

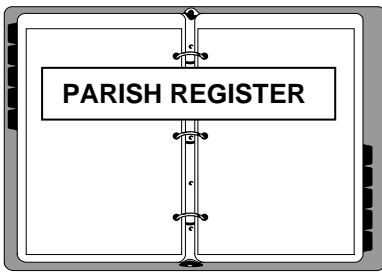
**Good Friday:** The adoration of the cross will be by profound bow from a distance and not by a kiss.

**The Easter Vigil:** There is no blessing of the Easter Fire and procession. A simple entrance takes place instead.

The long Old Testament readings will be restricted to three. The Easter water is blessed and is followed by the "Renewal of Baptismal Promises" but without the sprinkling of water.
