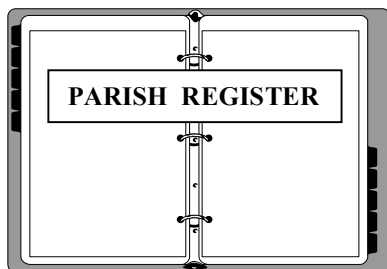
WORLD COMMUNICATIONS DAY – PENTECOST SUNDAY – NEXT WEEK
