#### ALL SAINTS DAY – HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION

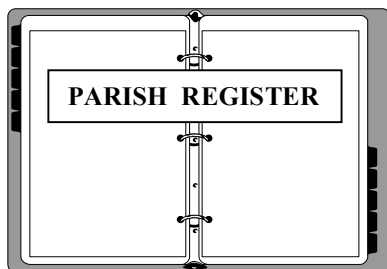
On **Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October 2017** (this week) the **Vigil Mass of All Saints** will be celebrated in **St. Mary's** at **7.30pm** and on the **Feast day itself, Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> November**, there will be two **Masses** in **St. Joseph's**, the first at **10am** and the second at **7.30pm**. This is one of the five Holy Days that are **NOT** transferred to the Sunday. We are therefore **obliged to attend Mass on the day of the feast**.

**ALL SOULS DAY** – On **Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> November** there will be two **Masses** for our **Holy Souls**, one in each church. The **morning Mass** will be in **St. Mary's** at **9.30am** and the **evening Mass** will be in **St. Joseph's** at **7.30pm**.

#### FIRST WORLD DAY OF THE POOR IS COMING

– **19<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER 2017** – Last June, **Pope Francis** announced that the 33<sup>rd</sup> Sunday of each year would be **World Day of the Poor** in the Catholic Church. He invited Catholics across the world to meet those in poverty IN ENCOUNTER: "It is my wish that Christian communities will make every effort to create moments of encounter and friendship, solidarity and concrete assistance." The Day is **to prepare us for the celebration of the Feast of Christ the King the following Sunday**. He hopes the Day will help us to reflect on the fact that an encounter with the poor is an encounter with Christ.

## NOVEMBER DEAD LISTS

During November, daily Masses are said for the Holy Souls. In particular for those named in the November Dead Lists which are placed on the altar. **Special envelopes are available at the back of both churches for your lists.** You do not have to enclose money in your envelope, but if you choose to do so, it will be donated to the **INTERNATIONAL REFUGEE TRUST (IRT)** whose projects we have supported in previous years. As we begin preparing for Christmas, millions of refugees are fleeing from conflict and living in crippling poverty. To them a joyful home is a distant memory. It feels particularly unjust that so many refugees and displaced families in Jordan, South Sudan and Uganda will go without adequate health care, hope and security this Christmas. These are just some of the countries where warfare and violence and poverty have shattered the hopes and dreams of an entire generation.

## THE NATIONAL COMMEMORATION OF THE 500<sup>th</sup> ANNIVERSARY OF THE REFORMATION IN WALES

On **Tuesday 31<sup>st</sup> October at 11am Archbishop George Stack** will lead Cytûn's service of commemoration for the **500<sup>th</sup> anniversary** of the beginning of the Reformation at **St. David's Catholic Cathedral, Cardiff**. It will be followed by **refreshments at 12 noon** and a **lecture on *The Catholicity of the Reformation*** by Professor Densil Morgan at **2pm**, both in **the Cornerstone**. It is an opportunity for Christians to **come together to help heal the divisions of the past** and to focus on what unites us, not what divides us. ## GOING INTO HOSPITAL?

Waiting to go into hospital? Do please let your parish priest know in plenty of time. He will be pleased to celebrate the Sacrament of the Sick with you or any pastoral support you need. This is preferable to leaving it until you are in hospital. The small team of parish priests who currently provide 24/7 emergency cover in the Cardiff hospitals are under a great deal of pressure, so unfortunately there is no guarantee that one is always available at any particular time. On the same theme, if you know of any Catholic already in hospital, who needs or might like a visit or sacramental support, please continue to leave details with the Cardiff & Vale Hospital Chaplaincy on 2074 3230.
