CAFOD Pyramid Boxes – Thank You for bringing in your filled boxes for exchange to new ones. Your contributions are being put to good use, as will be your CAFOD Lenten Fast Day donations. CAFOD's partners in Sierra Leone, for example, are training families to farm land which was previously thought to be barren and grow food all year round. This project has transformed land that was once the source of much brutality in the war into a source of hope and much needed food.
