

Holy Week - Day by Day

On Monday - Mass will be in St. Joseph's at 9.30am. On Tuesday - Mass will be in St. Mary's at 9.30am.

On Wednesday morning - the Chrism Mass takes place in St. David's Cathedral, Cardiff at 11.30am.

On Wednesday evening – The Mass of the Day will take place in St. Mary's, Dinas Powys at 7pm.

The Triduum

The Triduum begins on **Maundy Thursday** evening with Mass of the Lord's Supper at 7.30pm in St. Joseph's, followed by Eucharistic Adoration at the Altar of Repose (Lady Chapel) until 10.30pm. At 10.15pm the 5 Sorrowful Mysteries of the Holy Rosary will be recited, taking us from the Garden of Gethsemane to Calvary.

On **Good Friday** at 3pm we resume our journey in the footsteps of our Blessed Lord with the Solemn Good Friday Liturgy.

On **Holy Saturday** - at the Easter Vigil Mass in St. Joseph's at 8.30pm, our Catechumen, NICHOLAS ABBOTT, will receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist, joining us at the table of the Lord for the very first time.

Holy Week Services Cards

Specially printed cards are available today in both our churches showing the venue and times of the Holy Week services. Please take one and keep it in a prominent place in your homes.

All altar servers from St. Joseph's and St. Mary's are invited to exercise their ministry at the three main Services during the Triduum. Lists will be in both sacristies this weekend and Canon Joe would be grateful if each server could indicate his/her availability – and for which Services. There will be a REHEARSAL on Maundy Thursday morning at 11am in St. Joseph's for the Mass of the Lord's Supper and the Solemn Liturgy on Good Friday. Immediately following the Good Friday Liturgy there will be a REHEARSAL for the Easter Vigil Mass.
