CYCLE OF PRAYER FOR PARISHES.

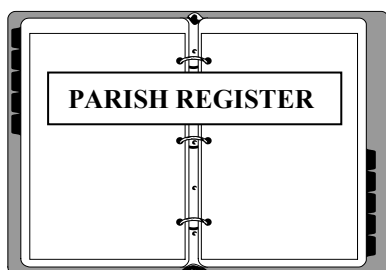
