UN CLIMATE TALKS IN GLASGOW TODAY.

The Conference of Parties (COP26) is the 26th United Nations Climate Conference, and begins today in Glasgow and id sue to run until 12th November. It will be attended by leaders from over 200 countries to discuss climate change and how to tackle the global ecological crisis.

The Bishops of England and Wales have asked us to make this a special time of prayer, so that the world leaders may work together for positive outcomes for the benefit of humankind and the planet.

At all masses today we will hear the words of our Archbishop George Stack, in his Pastoral Letter written a couple of weeks ago in the run-up to COP26. The Bishops, in partnership with Cafod, have produced a prayer card for use in the parish and in the home. A copy of the prayer will be handed out as you enter the church and we will all say the prayer together at the start of the Conference. It will then be for individuals to keep the prayer going privately, on a daily basis, throughout the next two weeks.
