#### SOLEMNITY OF MARY, MOTHER OF GOD

Before its change of title in 1969 **January 1st** was known as "the circumcision of our Lord". This was to be commemorated as the giving of the name Jesus to Mary's child. However, the principal object of the feast was the virginial motherhood of Mary, contemplated in the light of Christmas. The change of title amounted to little more than making explicit what was implicit in the Mass and Office of the octave of Christmas. Historians of the liturgy have long been aware that this feast of January 1st is the oldest celebration in honour of Our Lady in the Roman liturgy
